This summer our young people joined with over 100 teens from Maryland and Virginia to learn how to teach and run a 5-Day Club. Thank you to everyone who prayed for them and gave so generously to cover the costs. We are so thankful for the host and hostesses who helped secure the locations. We had four clubs in both St. Mary's and Calvert Counties with a total of 117 children attending these eight clubs. Twelve children are now a part of the family of God! We raised over \$320 for Miss Juvvy, the real-life missionary the children learned about at 5-Day Club. This money will help her purchase the \$1 devotional book, *Every Day with God*, for each student in her club. Over 320 children will be able to spend time every day with God in the Philippines because of the generosity of the children that came to 5-Day Clubs this summer in Southern Maryland.

At one club we had a family with four children, and the two older children prayed to receive Jesus and asked Him to forgive their sins. They did not want the 5-Day Club to end, so they started a Bible study in their basement—just like the 5-Day Club. What a blessing to see God draw their hearts to Himself.

God moved in beautiful ways in Calvert at Clubs in Drum Point, Broomes Island Community Center, Hallowing Point Park, and Emmanuel Baptist Church. Kids were excited about looking up Bible verses, memorizing Scripture, and some even wanted to help lead the song time.
